

# **Patriots Day**

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### **Beskrivelse**

Da tre bliver dræbt ved terrorbombninger under det traditionsrige marathonløb i Boston på Patriots Day i 2013 er verden og byen i chok. Men med den lidt kiksede politiassistent Saunders overraskende indsats sammen med effektivt arbejde fra FBI, lokalpolitiet og befolkningen afsløres gerningsmændene.

## Pædagogisk note

Vejledningerne er til gymnasiet og har to forskellige indgangsvinkler:

a) Tematisk arbejde med terror i engelsk, religion, hisorie og samfundsfag. b) Et kapitelsæt til brug i engelsk, hvor der arbejdes med filmanalyse.

Vejledningerne kan bruges til tematisk tværfagligt arbejde eller enkeltfagligt arbejde. Her arbejdes der med udgangspunkt i films tema uden en egentlig filmanalyse. Den egentlige filmanalyse ligger i kapitelsættet til filmen, hvor der stilles elevaktiverende spørgsmål (på engelsk), som eleven skal svare på, mens han/hun ser filmen. Alle de nævnte fag kan indgå i arbejdet samtidig, men vejledningerne kan også bruges alene i de enkelte fag.

### 01: Before you start

Make sure that you know the Hollywood Model; while watching the film note down the minute count for the exposition, rising action, crisis, point of no return, climax, resolution, and denouement.

02: 00:00:01 **Exposition** 

What do we learn in the exposition; who do you think the main character is - why?

#### 03: **Introduction of Various Characters**

The scenes in this chapter introduces several characters. Which role do you think they will play in the film?

04: The Saunders 00:06:47

Characterize Tommy Saunders and the Saunders' relationship.

#### 05: The Tsarnaev's residence

80:80:00

What do we learn from this scene. What is the young man watching on his computer? What is the effect of showing the woman and child in this scene as well?

06: **Going to Work** 00:11:09

How does Tommy Saunders feel about being assigned to the Boston Marathon?

#### 07: The morning of the Marathon

00:11:09

How is the Pugliese's and the Kensky's and Downe's morning depicted (notice sound as well as camera angles and lighting)? Why do you think the the director, Peter Berg, has chosen to include these scenes (compare to the next scenes at the Marathon)?

08: 00:12:53 The Marathon

Analyze the cinematic technique in this clip; you should look at angles, framing, lines, camera movement, composition, editing, lighting, color, filters, and sound.

09: The Bombs 00:25:02

Continue your analysis of the cinematic technique. Compare it to the scenes in the previous chapter.

10: The arrival of the FBI

Explain the discussion between the local police and the FBI. What does Rick Deslauriers mean when he says that 'Gentlemen, the moment we label this terrorism everything changes, it's not about Boston anymore, it's not a local investigation. It's Wolf Blitzer', it's stock markets, it's politicians. It's knee-jerk reactions and anti-muslim backlash.' Analyze camera movement.

Characterize FBI and Rick Delauriers in this chapter. How does the cinematic technique underline this?

Why and how has Tommy Saunders' role changed compared to the beginning og the movie?

What is the effect of this scene and why do you think it is placed inbetween a scene with the FBI and various scenes with victims of the bombs?

Analyse the cinematic technique in this chapter; what is the mood like?

Notice the difference in Tommy Saunders' reactions to his surroundings in this chapter. What does this tell us about Saunders?

Describe how the FBI and Saunders find their suspects. Cinematic technique: How is suspense build up in this chapter?

Why do you think the director has chosen to use excerpts from President Obama's speech in Boston? What is the effect of the cross-cutting in this chapter?

Who do you think the young men are? What is it they realize, and why do they react the way they do?

What do we learn about the bombers' motive? Describe the relationship between the two bombers and how it has developed.

During the interrogation Tsarnaev's wife says the following, 'For a muslim woman marriage is a wilting dance of duality. Strength and submission. Beautiful selfless rapturous love of two masters. A carnal and a divine. The life a muslim woman lives is a dangerous one; if she does not submit to her husband there is a spot reserved for her in Hell.' Please, analyze the quotation; what does it tell us about her attitude towards the bombings?
