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Beskrivelse

Engelsk dokumentar i to dele. Stephen Manderson alias rapperen professor Green sætter fokus på den mest dæmoniserede gruppe i det britiske samfund - hvide mænd fra arbejderklassen. De er ringere stillet end alle andre grupper og af samme grund udsat for hån, spot og latterliggørelse. For at forstå denne marginaliserede gruppe og se den moderne verden gennem deres øjne følger Stephen seks unge mænd på et afgørende tidspunkt i deres liv, hvor de oplever at starte på universitetet, forlade fængslet og blive fædre.

Pædagogisk note

Udsendelsen er egnet til at få et aktuelt billede på udfordringer hvide, unge mænd fra den britiske arbejderklasse står over for, men også konkrete indblik i muligheder og håb for den enkelte. Kapitelsættet kan bruges til en fælles introduktion og derefter til, at forskellige grupper følger en af de unge (se også udsendelse 1 i samme serie) og drøfter det, de ser fx ud fra kapitlernes overskrifter, spørgsmål eller statement, eller ud fra de forslag, der er nævnt i 'Introduction'. Grupperne kan efter eget arbejde gå på tværs af grupper og dele det, de ved og har talt om vedr. udsendelsens tema vist via konkrete personer og evt. vise vigtige nedslag fra udsendelsen for kammeraterne.

Jake has a day off from his full-time job. What worries does his mum have, Jake chosing a total different direction? Which role does Jake's family play for him to have self-confidence and go for his dream?
