Beskrivelse

Engelsk dokumentarserie i 6 dele fra 2011. Det strengt lukkede amishsamfund i Ohio åbner sine døre for seks engelske teenagere for at se, om de kan klare seks ugers hårdt arbejde og et liv helt uden moderne faciliteter. I første del bor de hos Jonathan og hans kone Marietta og oplever for første gang fællesskabet og samhørigheden, men også det hårde kønsopdelte arbejde helt uden moderne hjælpemidler.

Pædagogisk note

Denne TV-udsendelse er den første del i en serie på 6. Den beskriver unge englændere, der kommer på besøg i et Amishsamfund i USA. Englænderne undres over fx mangel af komfort, børnenes opdragelse og skolegang, kirken, de stærkt opdelte arbejdsområder mellem mænd og kvinder m.m. På den anden side ser de også sammenholdet, hjælpen der altid er lige om hjørnet, familielivets værdier, det trygge simple liv. I vejledningen nedenfor stilles netop skarp på det nuancerede billede af The Amish.

| | Aunt Erma grew up in the Amish society and left it for 18 years, but then returned. Explaining the girls why she came back is an eye opener for especially Sienna, who understands what positive impact a community may have on a person's life. | |

| | The last day ends with a cook out (barbecue) where mutual experiences and feelings are shared being part of each others' life for a week. | |
