They're talking with my dad, and me and my sisters are in another room, and we were hiding ourselves.
I really miss them, and I wish one day we could meet again, but I'm not sure if we could.
This is an Arabic song playing in the hotel, and the girls are dancing.
I'm with my friends, we are just walking. You can hear the sound of my friends laughing and talking to each other. We're just walking and it's so good.
Today me and my fiancé are out looking around for shopping. We have to buy some fruits and some snacks for tonight, because we have a gathering tonight with our families and it's a lovely day, and we're enjoying our time together.
One of the two things that we have these days is dreaming. I usually imagine myself going to work. It feels so good.
People are saying that travelling in time is impossible, but I can say that it's possible, for we travelled back 21 years.
Currently I'm on the bed. This is because we don't have any other things in this room to sit on. Only our bed, and we are here for more than 20 hours, 22 or maybe for the whole night and day - 24 hours. On our bed.
There are no more weekends for us, because every day we are free. Everyday we're home and we're not receiving any salaries.
I love the sound of feet in the snow while I'm walking. So beautiful. This year is going to be a good year for me. I'm sure.
Yesterday was my birthday. And it was the first time that I experienced it without my family.
Today, this morning I was in the bathroom, and I was taking shower, and my husband came and knocked on the door and when I opened the door, he was very happy and told me we got our tickets and I was very, very excited.
Here I am sitting in one of my relatives' basements, and I wanted to report other frustrating news.
